

I can confirm that the latest total costs of the actual demolition contract are

estimated at £95,111.22 as included in Item 3 of my letter dated 19th March 2014. The majority of the work is complete although there is still some work to be undertaken to reseed some of the area once the ground has settled. The cost of this seeding work is included in the above figure.

This demolition project was put out to competitive tender since the pre-tender estimate was above our threshold of £100,000. The expenditure of £137,493.90 quoted under Item 2 of my letter dated 19th March 2014 does not include the above cost of the demolition.
